Lindsborg Community Hospital and Bethany Home are the building blocks to start your health care profession. Nationwide shortages in the nursing field are increasing, but in McPherson County one local charitable organization is taking steps to help. The founding member of the organization was so impressed with the care and graciousness of CNAs during a hospital stay, he initiated the sponsorship of local CNA classes.

Four summer sessions are available, each session limited to 12 students. Classes meet only during the week, Monday - Friday. Tuition, books, fees and meals are underwritten 100%, with no cost to the student.



Certified Nursing Assistants (CNA) are responsible for the basic care of patients. They have different duties according to experience and the type of facility they serve. Duties may include assisting patients who are unable to feed themselves, bathing, grooming, dressing, helping patients to move about, measuring intake and output, measuring and recording vital signs, making beds, observing the patients mental, physical and emotional condition and reporting to the nursing or medical staff.

Students accepted for the scholarship will be given a letter of approval for a particular class session to be used when applying to Hutchinson Community College.

- ▶ HCC Application
- ▶ Brief Reading Test

Students need to be at least 16 or a Junior in high school if seeking college credit. The student must secure permission through their school principal before the end of spring semester even if they will be graduating. Permission form

Requirements

- Submit Application to LCH by: March 14, 2018
- Commitment to 14 days of training
- Come to Sessions prepared (paper, pencil, books and full attention)
- TB skin test - TB tests will be given at LCH for those needing test. Positive tests require chest x-rays at student expense.
- Social Security Card & Drivers License (first day of class)
- Must be 16 or older by the first day of class.
