- Brief reading test

Students need to be at least 16 or a Junior in high school if seeking college credit. The student must secure verification through their school principal before the end of spring semester even if they will be graduation. Verification form must be turned in with application.

Requirements

- Submit application to LCH by March 24th, 2025
- Commitment to 14 working days of training
- Come to Sessions prepared (paper, pencil, books, and full attention)
- TB skin test TB tests will be given at LCH for those needing a test. Positive tests require chest x-rays at students expense.
- <u>Must be 16 or older by the first day of class</u>
- Dress Appropriately
